But know this, that if the master of the house had known what hour the thief would come, he would have watched and not allowed his house to be broken into. Therefore you also be ready, for the Son of Man is coming at an hour you do not expect.

As we step into the new year of 2024 we sense an urgency to highlight the topic of "being prepared". Prepared for what? We are not at all suggesting that Jesus is returning in 2024 (although that would be OK with us) but are believers prepared to face the spiritual (and possibly physical) attacks that some are suggesting 2024 will bring?

It is interesting to us that the warning the Lord gave us in "Stand by for Heavy Rolls" several years ago, and has brought it to our attention again recently, that other ministers are being shown similar pictures of what lies ahead. Rick Renner, for instance, in a recent newsletter tells of a prophetic word the Lord gave him while on a flight to a certain city, and experienced some heavy turbulence. According to Rick Renner, the Lord showed him that episodes of turbulence could be expected especially in the financial, political and national realms.

Looking at the world situation right now, it is pretty easy to see the possibility of things getting "bumpy" in 2024. What can we do? In Stand by for Heavy Rolls, the Lord showed us through scripture the importance of staying close to God, staying close to His Word, and staying close to and loving one another. In the message the Lord showed Rick Renner, the solution for believers is to: stay in faith, stay in peace, stay in love, stay in fellowship, and keep sowing seed for the sake of eternity. Sounds very similar doesn't it?

For those who remain steadfast in following the above recommendations, even though the world may seem to be collapsing in front of them, they can experience supernatural peace, assurance, provision and victory.

There is one more thing: Preparation is not something you do when the attack comes, it must be done as far in advance as possible to be successful. We are in a battle, and

In Luke 5:7 When Jesus had used Simon Peter's boat as a platform to teach from, it says: "So they signaled to their partners in the other boat to come and help them. And they came and filled both the boats, so that they began to sink."

There was such a supernatural catch of fish that Simon needed help from his partners to take in the catch. Partners are critical to achieving success - especially in ministry.
