November in the United States is a month with a day that is designated for Thanksgiving. Our friends in Canada already had a day of Thanksgiving in October. This November, we are especially thankful for God's provision and His protection for several reasons.

As many of you know, Florida was hit with hurricane Ian in late September. The original forecast was for Ian to make landfall in the Tampa Bay area, and had already built itself to a category 4 when it made a sudden turn East, and made landfall in the Fort Meyers area. The devastation in the path of the hurricane was unbelievable. Storm surges caused major flooding along the coast and even inland as far as Orlando, major flooding occurred as more than two feet of rain fell in a matter of just a few hours.

While we had some strong winds and some rain just a couple of hundred miles North, we had absolutely no damage to our property, nor did anyone in our whole neighborhood. The Lord is good and His mercy is everlasting! We are thankful for the prayers of so many of you who were concerned about our welfare. Continued prayer is appropriate for those still recovering from the storm.

We are also thankful to be able to get back to Hungary again. Strategic places in Europe are finally open to travel, and we are excited to meet face to face with people we haven't seen in person for over two years. In fact, by the time you receive this newsletter we will already be in Hungary. We appreciate your prayers for us as we minister there along with Pastor Thomas Lohnke from Switzerland.

Although we have not been there in person, we have continued to teach weekly using Skype and telephone. Wednesdays we teach Bible lessons (I teach and Marta translates, making me look good) and on Thursdays Marta

leads a prayer meeting which includes teaching and practical application of prayer principles.

While it's not the same as being there in person, we are seeing amazing results from both Wednesday and Thursday sessions. Every teaching session is recorded (MP3 format) and E-mailed to the people in the group, and to others who can't be with us at the time we teach. These teaching are reaching not only Hungary and Romania, but Germany, Austria, Australia and the U.S. We are finding out that some of these listeners will forward the teaching on to friends and family in other parts of those countries, so we really have no idea how many families are being impacted by these sessions. Thankful!


I must also let you know that the atmosphere surrounding these sessions has been amazing! Just a few days ago as I was working at my computer while Marta was leading the prayer group (needing no translation) I could sense a very strong anointing on the teaching. It was amazing! Have I mentioned amazing? Thankful!

Pastor Istvan Sule and his wife Szilvia, who oversee a small group in Ózd, Hungary, also travel twice a month to the town of Szakcs, 335 kilometers (over 200 miles) each way to help teach and train the people there. In Szakcs, Norbi Rozsa and his wife Aniko have been leading the group there, Norbi is finishing the first year of the Light to the Nations Bible school, and we believe he is the right person to become the Pastor of the church in Szakcs when he is ready.

Thank you for your prayers and financial support for Light to the Nations Ministries. Your partnership in this ministry is making a huge difference in the lives of many in Hungary and Romania and beyond. We are truly thankful for you!
