But let's go back – 33 years this month we were preparing for an historic move to Belarus to follow God's leading to start a church in Minsk! We had just turned the school over to Libby and were leaving in 5 weeks with a team of 21 from Good Shepherd to help start the church in Minsk. We had no more time to learn Russian, only the alphabet! It is a testament to God's grace and wisdom and plans that the church actually started! After the team left, we knew no one – only a translator. And, about 10 years later he became the first national director of Christ for the Nations, Belarus!

The five years we spent in Minsk — a city of 2 million — were amazing and the people God brought to Abundant Life Church are still significant in our lives! Thanks to technology, we can still see them and talk to them! We got to be a part of the founding team for CFN. We met with the current director – a student from the first year – last night as God is opening new doors in the former Soviet Union. Isn't that incredible! **RELATIONSHIPS** are primary in the **Kingdom of God!**

We will share some of these relationships with you of people that call us Beloved, Papa and Mama or Pastors

Roger and Myrna. God is opening new doors for us into Belarus, Poland, the former USSR, and even Turkey. Are you ready to go through some of these doors with us?

Pastors Pavel and Iryna Anosov and family Nations Church, Wroclaw, Poland

They were the ones we put in to replace us in ALC in Minsk. They moved to Poland 8 years ago – now God is using them in an almost totally immigrant church. So much love there – and creativity goes forth even through their sons! Their latest report:



Our church is growing in every aspect! With God's grace, we changed the building and with that comes new financial, administrative challenges. Our media, worship, sound and other ministries are in the process of growth and reconstruction to create stability in our teams. We also created new positions in our church, like stage presenter, administrative manager and Sunday service manager.

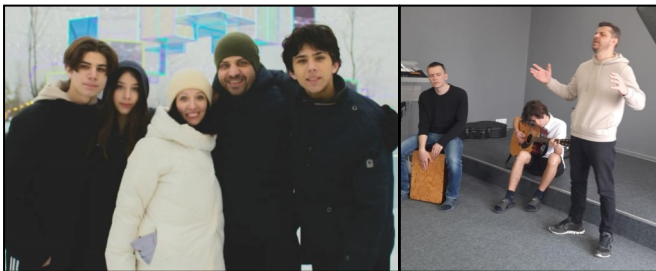
Despite all these challenges, we didn't lose people from the move — 250 to 300 each week. We didn't stop our Women's Meetings with around 60 attending, or home groups and Youth Meetings. God opened doors

for us to continue serving people even in the larger scale! God brings new people to our church; every Sunday people are getting saved! God also opened hearts of our people to serve even with their cars to help others come to the church, because new place is located further away than the old one.

We trust God, and we believe that he will do even greater things through us to His glory and His Kingdom! Eph 3:20: "Now to him that is able to do exceedingly abundantly above all that we ask or think, according to the power that works in us,"

We are also in weekly contact with the present pastors there in Minsk. **Dennis and Lena Pravazorov** are so faithful. They also run the Full Gospel Bible School. Both ministries are prospering. We ask for prayer for them and Belarus – dangerous place to be and come and go from. A KGB agent keeps wanting to talk to Dennis – not sure what he is “fishing” for! But this was the prayer request – not for safety, but that Dennis might have the opportunity to share the Gospel with him!!! Yes, and may it be so. PLEASE pray!

Dear Pastors Roger and Myrna, We continue to trust God and serve Him with dedication. We see His faithful care for our family every day, how He answers our prayers and supports us in all things. We often remember how, when the full-scale war began in Ukraine in 2022, we were faced with a difficult decision – whether to leave the country as refugees or stay and continue our ministry. During a time of fasting and prayer, the Holy Spirit renewed our vision, strengthened our faith, and ignited God's fire in our hearts. We made the decision to remain in Ukraine, and we are still here, serving. * 16 years

Even in the midst of the difficult realities of war, we experience God's grace in ministry. We are building a team, caring for our church, doing humanitarian outreach, preaching God's Word, teaching, and praying. And the Lord is moving! Many people are coming to faith in Jesus Christ, receiving salvation, experiencing

healing and restoration, and growing spiritually. “But thanks be to God, who always leads us as captives in Christ's triumphal procession and uses us to spread the aroma of the knowledge of Him everywhere.” (2 Corinthians 2:14)

In addition to regular church gatherings, much of our ministry is now focused on online Bible courses – like Encounter with God and Discovering God. We also serve youth and married couples. We receive many testimonies and words of gratitude, which are a precious reward to us. (side note: about 300 in online programs)

We are in need of financial support and would be truly grateful for any help. Thank you for your prayers – for us and for Ukraine. May the Lord richly bless you!

Revelation Church, Gdansk, Poland



They were in Egypt on vacation when the war started in Ukraine. They could not get back to their home. They ended up in Gdynia at our Bible school where we met them. God knit us together. They moved to Gdansk and started the church there. We would like to take a team this fall to help them evangelize and bring encouragement to them.

We are a team of immigrants who have God's heart for building an international church in Gdansk, where everyone can feel at home, regardless of their origin. Our main dream is for as many young people as possible to dedicate their lives to serving God, so we try to set an example and create opportunities for this.

The main ministries of the church are: worship, media and children's. We use four languages: Ukrainian, Russian, English, Polish. Due to the fact that we understand the pain and challenges that immigrants face (they have no home, no relatives, they do not know the language, the culture...), our mission is to provide spiritual support and help in easier integration.

they worked with former Imams and former terrorist, as well as other leaders working in this area. They did 18 KC lessons with 40 interns who will be going into some of the darkest and most intense regions.

God did much inner healing; a tumor disappeared, worship levels grew radical!! They learned how people are using the Koran as the means of leading people to Jesus through references to Him — but then show that He is the Son of God. Even some mosques have become Christian churches! Lord, thank You for Your love for all!

We will do another newsletter in June to give updates on new things in the USSR, and the trip to Poland that some of you might want to support or go on! We covet your prayers for continued good health, a healing for Myrna's knees, and for financial and prayer support. We cannot go unless we are sent. But we can all go as we unite with vision!

Thanks for sharing this time with us. Your support, prayers, and enthusiasm encourage us to keep pressing into what He has promised for Ram's Horn Ministry! He says we have only laid the groundwork, and the fore-running. That NOW we shall see the harvest — greater harvest of what we have labored for! That is not only us — but all who participate!
